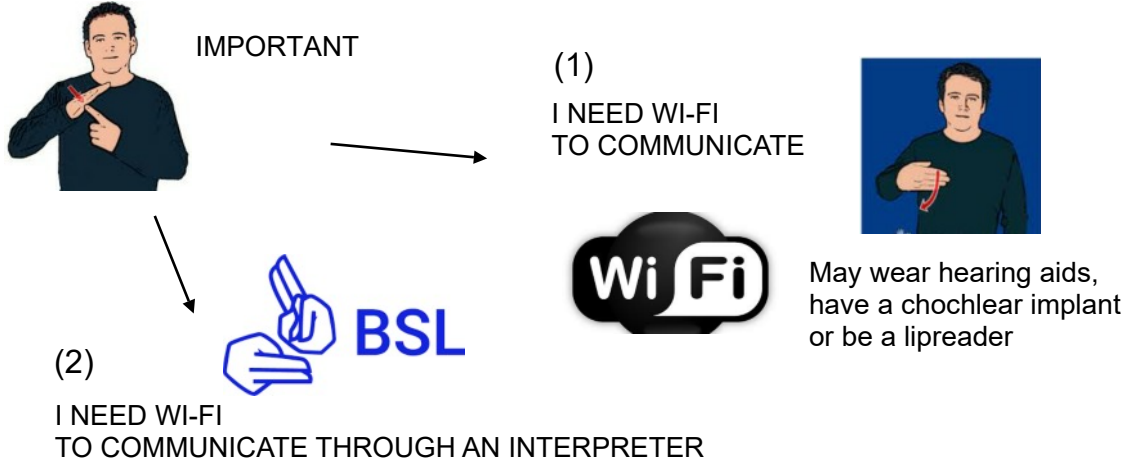

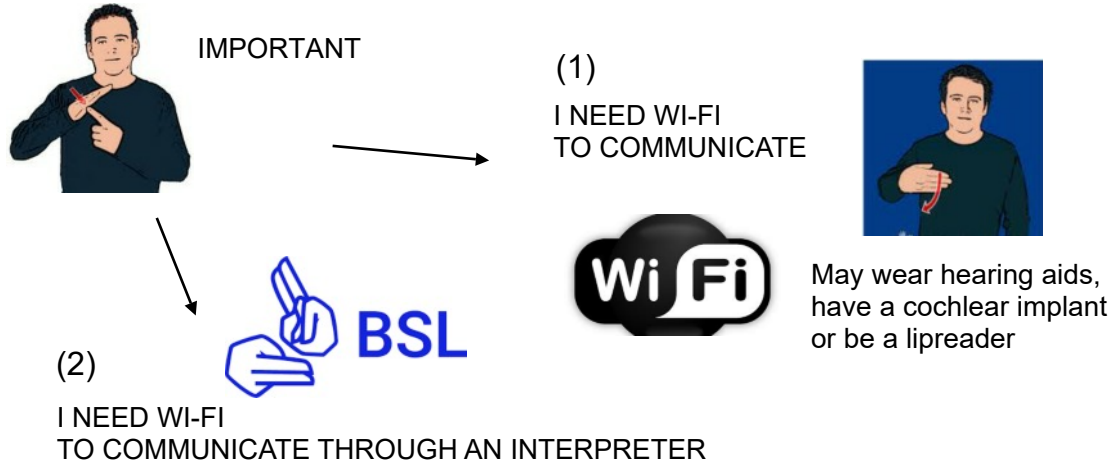

### IMPORTANT FOR DEAF PATIENTS:

Tell hospital you need Wi-Fi to help you communicate  
Make sure you know how to contact interpreter by text if BSL  
Make sure you remind people - facemask is a problem  
Emergency ask hospital phone: **01209 823103** or **07877 654543**

If you have a smartphone, put on the apps you need to communicate, and bring your smartphone with you.  
Bring an emergency bag with items you need  
Put your name on bag and your items

### Put in bag:

1. Smart phone or tablet, plugs and chargers
2. Paper and pens or markers or non-magnetic dry erase board
3. A power pack in case your bed is far from electric socket
4. Your reading glasses to read your phone
5. Extra batteries for your hearing aid, cochlear implant, or listening device
6. Headband to keep HA/CL if need ventilator
7. Any special information hospital need know
8. Emergency contact information for family members or friends
